At 9:40 we will have class time and we will join different groups. It will be the time to share your missionary experiences with others, time for prayer and care for others, and time to study the Word of God. We are also planning to organize a new class for newly baptized people and those who have been in the church for a short time. We want the Sabbath School classes to be strong groups that will have a holistic character. We want to accomplish the four goals of the Saturday School: study of the Word, fellowship and nurture, community outreach and world mission emphasis.
