### **Message from the Treasurer**

A church member recently asked how much of the tithe goes towards the upkeep of Trinity Church. This query made me realise that there are visitors and even members who do not completely understand how the finances are distributed in the SDA church. The only donations that can be used by Trinity Gardens Church are those given to (1) Local Ministries and (2) Special Projects. Local Ministries is used to pay expenses, such as water, heating, insurance, cleaning, gardening, etc., etc. Special Projects is used to cover items, such as alterations to the kitchen, and other projects that we could not afford out of the Local Ministries. All tithe that is returned, is automatically handled by the SA Conference, as is the Sabbath School Mission and the many other offerings taken up at Trinity Gardens Church.

#### **Tithes/Offerings**

The Treasurers fully understand that some members prefer to give to the Church anonymously and we are very happy for this to continue. However, it would be appreciated if you would indicate which account (listed inside the tithe envelope) you would like your donation to go to and how much money you have put in the tithe envelope. This eliminates errors with banking and also the envelopes are retained for audit purposes. Please be aware that if you leave the inside of the tithe envelope blank, the donation is automatically allocated to tithe, and Trinity Gardens church will not benefit from your donation. Thanks, so much for continuing to give to the Lord.
